Old Business

Disposal of Desktop & Laptop Computers

Small Acreage Invasive Species Program

Andy shared the tools that the staff purchased after last month's meeting. To create 2 complete sets, it ended up being a total cost of \$656.26. Tom Schneider made a motion to approve the additional money to have 2 complete sets, with a second from Dan Megel.

Tom mentioned later in the meeting that we may want to investigate purchasing some tank clean out to maintain our sprayers. The staff will investigate this and report back to the board.

New Business

Drill Update

A landowner rented the No-Till Drill and had someone else pull it for him. That person was unaware that he needed it in transport mode and did some damage to it. The Landowner made the repairs from his own pocket. At the same time there was an issue with what was thought to be a wheel bearing. Jacobi Sales went to the farm and made the necessary repair. The part will be covered under warranty and the district will be responsible for the labor and service call.

Letter of Intent

Andy shared with the board a Letter of Intent to apply for a 319 for the Vernon Fork of the Muscatatuck River watershed. Dan Megel made a motion to proceed with a second from Tom Schneider.
